
Paul Sinclair Award for Outstanding Contribution to AUSIT

NOMINATION GUIDELINES

Background

In 2009, AUSIT National Council announced the establishment of the 'Paul Sinclair Award for Outstanding Contribution to AUSIT' to honour the late Paul Sinclair's contribution to the association and the profession.

The Paul Sinclair Award for Outstanding Contribution to AUSIT has been awarded three times to date:

- 2009 – to the AUSIT Queensland Branch Committee, for the financial contribution made by the 2008 National Conference;
- 2011 – to Rod Wahl, for leading the AUSIT Constitutional Review project in 2010; and
- 2013 – to Christian Schmidt, for leading the AUSIT Code of Ethics review.

On all these occasions, several candidates for the Paul Sinclair Award were nominated and the final decision was made by NC members voting anonymously.

Nominations

Nominations and entries can be made by AUSIT Branch committee members and National Council members.

Nominations must address how the individual has:

- demonstrated a commitment to high performance and strived for excellence in their activity that benefited AUSIT; and/or
- displayed leadership; and/or
- been an inspirational role model for the profession.

Criteria

Selection criteria will include evidence of:

- achievements, and/or
- consultation and research in the execution of the nominee's work, and/or
- verifiable and/or measurable outcomes.

Candidates must:

- have appropriate NAATI accreditation or equivalent qualifications or recognition,
- have their primary residence in Australia.

How to nominate:

Nominations must be submitted electronically as a single Word or PDF document via email to AUSIT_NC@yahoogroups.com and include:

- completed nomination form (see below)
- details of two referees
- supporting documentation (if appropriate).

Nominations close at 5 pm on 30 September 2017.
